## Activist Will Roll out Demands to End Abuses of NYPD Gang Policing

(NEW YORK, NY) – Since 2014, thousands of New Yorkers – including hundreds of children – have been <u>added</u> to the New York City Police Department's secretive gang database. During that span, Mayor Bill de Blasio and the NYPD have launched dozens of militarized gang takedowns – "precision policing" – targeting mostly Black and Latinx communities based on gang associations.

On Thursday, December 12, 2019 community members and legal organizations will rally at City Hall to announce a targeted campaign aimed at ending the abuses of gang policing in New York City.
