Body Storage & NYC Health/Hospitals	NYC Health/Hospitals are required to hold a body for 6 weeks however, because they are at capacity due to COVID-19 crisis, funeral directors are finding that after 1-2 weeks, the hospitals are already processing the body transferring to the city morgue for Hart's Island. If able, families should try to release the deceased's body from the hospital. Once the body is transferred to the city morgue, there is a delay (3 hours) before the body can be released to the funeral home and given the current situation, funeral homes are struggling with this waiting time and may refuse to get involved.
