You will be connected to a representative or will be asked to leave a detailed message.</p> <p>You can file a report online anonymously which does not require your contact information. It is translated into all AAPI languages (look for the language sign in the upper right hand corner)</p>	<p>You may be required to fill out a questionnaire or provide information about the incident. You may be able to do so anonymously if you are not seeking damages or other kinds of court proceedings.</p>

You will be connected to an interpreter at the precinct, but it may take time.</p>	<p>Requires going to a police precinct or District Attorney’s Office, speaking with officials, and filing a police report. You cannot report anonymously. To bring criminal charges, you may be required to sign a corroborating affidavit and/or testify. LEAs are not</p>

<p>Stop AAPI Hate</p>	<p>https://stopaapihate.org/</p> <p>STOP AAPI Hate ¹⁰is an organization that allows someone to report a hate crime without going through a formal investigation. Information is collected & data is used to understand what is happening in communities and to support advocacy efforts on local, regional, and national levels.</p>	<p>You will be required to fill out an online questionnaire that takes approximately 7-10 minutes. The form can be translated into over 12 AAPI languages. You can report anonymously and your personal information will not be shared with law enforcement.</p>
