Stop AAPI Hate	https://stopaapihate.org/ STOP AAPI Hate ¹⁰ is an organization that allows someone to report a hate crime without going through a formal investigation. Information is collected & data is used to understand what is happening in communities and to support advocacy efforts on local, regional, and national levels.	You will be required to fill out an online questionnaire that takes approximately 7-10 minutes. The form can be translated into over 12 AAPI languages. You can report anonymously and your personal information will not be shared with law enforcement.
