Legal Aid Statement on the Biden Administration's New Protections for Undocumented Spouses of U.S. Citizens and "Dreamers"

(NEW YORK, NY) – The Legal Aid Society released the following statement in response to a new executive order issued by President Joe Biden that will shield certain undocumented spouses of U.S. citizens from deportation, allow them to obtain work authorization, provide a pathway to permanent resident status, as well as streamline work visa access for some "Dreamers":

"While we are waiting on details, we laud President Biden for using his executive power to protect as many as 500,000 people who have been waiting in immigration limbo for years, without a pathway to citizenship. These new protections will keep families and communities together and help fortify our economy.

"However, these measures, while welcomed, should not supplant the need for more humane and comprehensive immigration reform, and we again urge Congress to pass robust legislation that will provide relief for long-term undocumented immigrants."
