Statement in Response to Legislation Decriminalizing Jaywalking Becoming Law

(NEW YORK, NY) - The Legal Aid Society released the following statement in response to <u>legislation</u> to decriminalize jaywalking becoming law:

"Decriminalizing jaywalking in New York City is long-overdue and eradicates a mechanism that the New York City Police Department (NYPD) has, for decades, employed as a pretext to stop, question, and frisk New Yorkers, especially those from communities of color.

"With this legislation now codified, we hope that both the Adams Administration and the City Council will continue to abolish relic laws that serve no public safety purpose and only ensuare people in the criminal legal system.

"We thank the City Council for championing and passing this important legislation and we will closely monitor implementation to ensure that the NYPD fully follows the spirit and intent of this needed reform."
