

## New York Can End Child Poverty Campaign *Rally to End Child Poverty* at the New York State Capitol

ALBANY, NOV. 19 - The <u>New York Can End Child Poverty</u> coalition will hold a *Rally to End Child Poverty* on November 19, at 2 p.m. following a Child Poverty Reduction Act Council (CPRAC) meeting. Over 200 people are expected to rally at the front of the New York State Capitol in support of New York's pursuit of its <u>child poverty reduction goals</u>.

The group of supporters and members is comprised of parents, legislators, educators, health care providers, child care providers, economists, labor unions, faith leaders, advocates, and more.

The coalition has been leading the way in ensuring that the state follows through on its goal of reducing child poverty by 50% by 2032. This rally comes ahead of a scheduled vote in December during which CPRAC will vote to issue a report on public policy recommendations to help the state meet its child poverty reduction goal.
