


If the police come to your door, you don't have to let them in unless they have a warrant signed by a judge!*



IF THEY ONLY HAVE A REMOVAL ORDER OR AN ICE WARRANT, YOU DON'T HAVE TO LET THEM IN. YOU CAN SAY:

"I do not consent to a search of my home. Please do not come inside."

IF THE POLICE OR IMMIGRATION OFFICERS ENTER YOUR HOME, YOU SHOULD NOT RESIST. BUT YOU HAVE THE RIGHT TO REMAIN SILENT IF THEY ASK ANY QUESTIONS.
