## Domestic Violence Survivors, LGBTQ, Civil Rights and Immigrant Advocates Call for Preliminary Injunction Blocking ICE from Rikers

On Tuesday, June 3rd, Judge Mary Rosado of New York Supreme Court will hear oral arguments from both the New York City <u>Anti-Violence Project</u> as well as a coalition of Immigrant, Civil Rights Groups and Public Defenders led by the <u>Legal Aid Society</u>. The organizations submitted amicus briefs in support of the New York City Council's lawsuit urging the court to block Executive Order 50 which seeks to return ICE and federal agencies to Rikers Island, ensuring immediate and irreparable harm to incarcerated immigrants, their families, and entire communities across New York City.

Following the hearing, advocates, organizers and attorneys will gather on the courthouse steps to brief the press on the hearing and what comes next, and speak to why we are joining together to speak out against the Executive Order.
