***Disability Rights Advocates, Home Care Workers, Labor Organizations, and Legal Service Providers to Rally at City Hall Urging “NO” Vote on Intro 303 Ahead of City Council Vote in April***

***Proposed bill would leave people without care, forcing them into institutions while destabilizing home care system for workers***

**(New York, NY)** — On Wednesday, April 1, a broad coalition of disability rights advocates, home care workers, labor organizations, and legal service providers will hold a press conference on the steps of City Hall calling on the New York City Council to vote **NO** on Intro 303 ahead of its scheduled April vote.

Speakers will include disabled New Yorkers who would be directly impacted if the bill passes, alongside workers and advocates. Participants will warn that the proposed “No 24-Hour Care” bill, as currently written, would destabilize the home care system — putting thousands of older adults and people with disabilities at risk of losing critical services while also threatening jobs for home care workers.
