The Legal Aid Society to Be Honored as “Flagstar Harbor Hero of the Game” at Staten Island FerryHawks Game

Honor Comes as Legal Aid Celebrates 150 Years of Serving New Yorkers

(STATEN ISLAND, NY) - The Legal Aid Society will be recognized as the “Flagstar Harbor Hero of the Game” by the Staten Island FerryHawks during the team’s game on Friday, June 12, at Staten Island University Hospital Community Park.

The event will celebrate The Legal Aid Society’s ongoing commitment to serving Staten Island communities through high-quality legal advocacy and support services. Members of Legal Aid’s Staten Island office will participate in an on-field recognition ceremony before the game.

This recognition is part of a broader series of events marking The Legal Aid Society’s 150th anniversary, including upcoming partnerships with BRIC Arts Media Celebrate Brooklyn!, El Museo del Barrio, the Queens Museum, and Rooftop Films and Snug Harbor.

As part of the anniversary celebration, The New York Historical is currently hosting “[Delivering Justice: 150 Years of The Legal Aid Society](#),” on view through July 5, 2026. The exhibit explores how Legal Aid’s work has shaped New York City’s legal and social landscape through rare archival materials, historic photographs, original documents, and contemporary artwork examining the intersection of justice, advocacy, and social change.
